With reference to the subject matter, I am desired to say that the Dental Council of India, vide their letter No.DE-15(43)-2000/13813, dated 21st March, 2001, have indicated that their General Body at its meeting held on 5-6 March, 2001 considered the Joint Inspection Report of the Council's Inspectors, (1) Dr. Suresh Meshram and (2) Dr. Vimal Sikri, and the Compliance Report dated 27.2.2001 thereon from the college authorities and decided as under:

"That the Joint Inspection Report may be noted.

The Council may recommend to the Central Government to recognise the BDS degree awarded by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of BDS students of K.V.G. Dental College & Hospital, Sullia from 60 to 100 if granted on or after 5th November, 2000".
