

Government of Karnataka have considered the recommendation of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore and decided to issue Essentiality and Feasibility Certificate for increase in intake of MDS Course as mentioned below for the academic year 2018-19 subject to the condition that the institution shall give an undertaking in the form of an MOU to the effect that the percentage of seats will be determined from time to time shall be surrendered to Government of Karnataka quota as per Consensual Agreement that will be entered into from time to time or as fixed in the Karnataka Professional Educational Institution (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006.

Therefore, as per Section 10 A of the Dentists' Act, 1948 read with Regulation 6 (4) of the Dental Council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges, opening of new or higher course of study or Training and increase of admissions capacity in Dental Colleges) Regulations 2006, the Government of Karnataka hereby grants the issue of Essentiality and Feasibility Certificate for increase in intake of MDS courses as mentioned above for the academic year 2018-19 to KVG Dental College & Hospital, Sulia-574327 in the prescribed format as below:

It possesses the basic infrastructural facilities including a functional hospital to effectively manage and administer the college as well as the teaching hospital.

The KVG Dental College & Hospital, Sulia-574327 has applied for increase in intake of MDS courses as mentioned above at Dakshina Kannada. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Karnataka have decided to issue of Essentiality and Feasibility Certificate for increase in intake of MDS courses as mentioned above for the academic year 2018-19.

It is certified that: -

- a. The applicant owns and manages a 600 bedded hospital.
- a. The applicant owns and manages a dental clinic with 366 Chairs.
- b. It is desirable to establish a Dental college in the public interest.
- c. Minimum dental out patients per day are available to begin with.
- d. The credibility and the financial status of the applicant has been verified.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Dental College as per DCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the

Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.

Issuance of Essentiality and Feasibility Certificate is subject to the condition that the institution shall give an undertaking in the form of a MOU to the effect that the percentage of seats will be determined from time to time shall be surrendered to Government of Karnataka quota as per Consensual Agreement that will be entered into from time to time or as fixed in the Karnataka Professional Educational Institution (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 and strictly adopt and adhere to the State policy on admission of students and charging of fee to medical colleges as stipulated from time to time.
